**ROTARY INFORMATION:** The 4-way Test...

Chicago Rotarian Herbert J. Taylor who, in the summer of 1932 had a serious business problem formulated the Rotary 4-way test. How he solved it is a legend of Rotary. In 1968 Taylor wrote: "I leaned over my desk, rested my head in my hands, and prayed. After a few moments, I looked up and reached for a white paper card. Then I wrote down the twenty-four words that had come to me:

**Is it the truth?**

**Is it fair to all concerned?**

**Will it build good will and better friendships?**

**Will it be beneficial to all concerned? "**

Rotary International adopted the "Four Way Test" in January of 1943. You can read about it on the Rotary history website at

Herbert Taylor went on to become President of Rotary International 1954-55. The 4-Way Test is also used by Walgreens Drug Stores as the firm's set of guiding principles to guide employees to consider when making decisions about what they think, say or do.

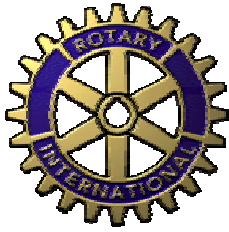
